Dear Eighth Grade Students and Parents:

On February 9, 2017, an 8th grade assembly was held to inform students of eligibility requirements for the 8th grade picnic. The 8th grade picnic is an earned privilege, so all LISD middle school assistant principals will be meeting with their respective campuses to discuss the consistent guidelines and expectations that have been established.

It is critical that all students and their parents understand the eligibility requirements. Eligibility is primarily based on a student's behavior and attendance.

The expectations are as follows:

- A student may receive no more than **three (3)** disciplinary referrals between February 9th and the picnic date, June 1st, 2017.
- A student may not receive **any** I.S.S. or L.E.O. assignments from now until June 1st.
- Students who have been assigned Saturday Clock Hours to make up absences must have their time completed in order to be eligible to attend the trip.
- All textbook and library fines must be paid by May 31st.
- All cafeteria charges must be paid by May 31st.
- Any Lenovo issues must be resolved by May 31st.

Our 8th grade picnic will be held at Milburn Park on June 1st, 2017.

If a student does not meet any of the expectations listed above, he/she will be staying at school for the day.
